## 1) NOTEWORTHY TOPICS OF DISCUSSION, SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION, AND OUTCOME OF DISCUSSION

**The AV Safety Subcommittee held 5 virtual meetings to date in 2021:**

**February 10** – This was a joint meeting with the System Technology and Data Security Subcommittee, with a presentation and discussion on UL4600. After that, the Safety Subcommittee had a discussion about their updated charter and NHTSA Final Rule: Modernize Driverless Vehicle Safety Standards.

**April 14** – The group was given an update on SSB5460 and WTSC’s project on ADAS Survey and Education Plan. There were two presentations: Pavement Markings (by Doug McClanahan, WSDOT), and “What the Heck is Level 3?” (by Roger Lanctot, Strategy Analytics).

**May 12** – There were two presentations: Autonomous Vehicle Policy: A driving test for self-driving cars? (by Michelle Avary - Head, Automotive and Autonomous Mobility, World Economic Forum), and Replaying real life: how the Waymo Driver avoids fatal human crashes (by Aidan Ali-Sullivan, Waymo).

**June 9** – There was one presentation: Autonomous Vehicle – Law Enforcement Considerations (by Brian Ursino, Director, Law Enforcement, American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators).

**September 8** – The group was introduced to our new co-chair, Captain Dennis Bosman from Washington State Patrol and there was one presentation: AV Use-Cases & Regulation (by Egil Juliussen, Ph.D., Consultant & Columnist, EE Times)
