

 - Examples to further explain ideas





- Informational ranking survey on revised strategies & actions (~ June August 2020)
 - Informs Infrastructure & Systems Subcommittee on potential priorities
 - Provides another data point when agencies are exploring future investments in the near-term
- Present revised strategies & actions, and informational ranking results to Infrastructure & Systems Subcommittee for discussion and final prioritization recommendations (~ September 2020)
- Encourage other Subcommittees to develop their goals, strategies & actions (Ongoing)
- Recommend revised strategies & actions, and prioritization to AV Executive Committee and Transportation Commission for adoption (~ September – December 2020)
