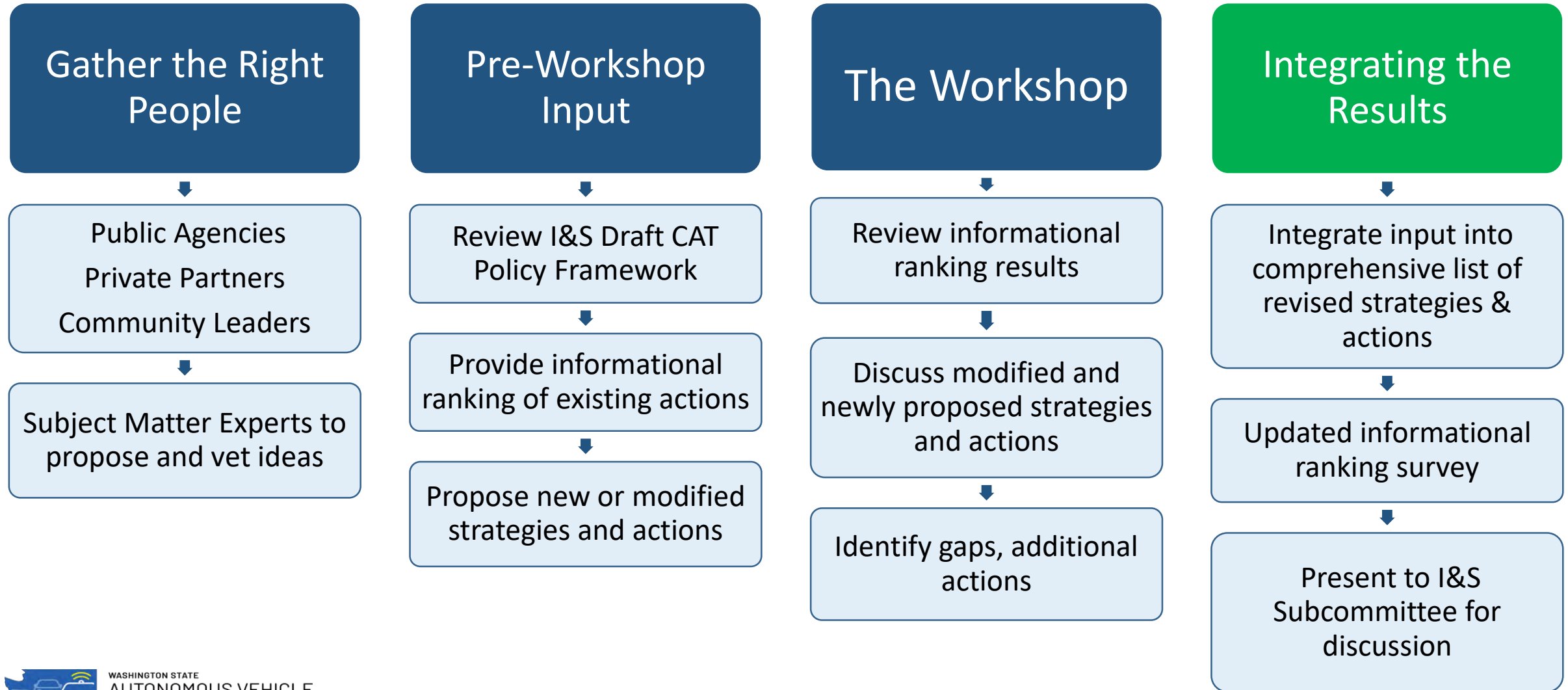

# CAT Policy Framework Development Process

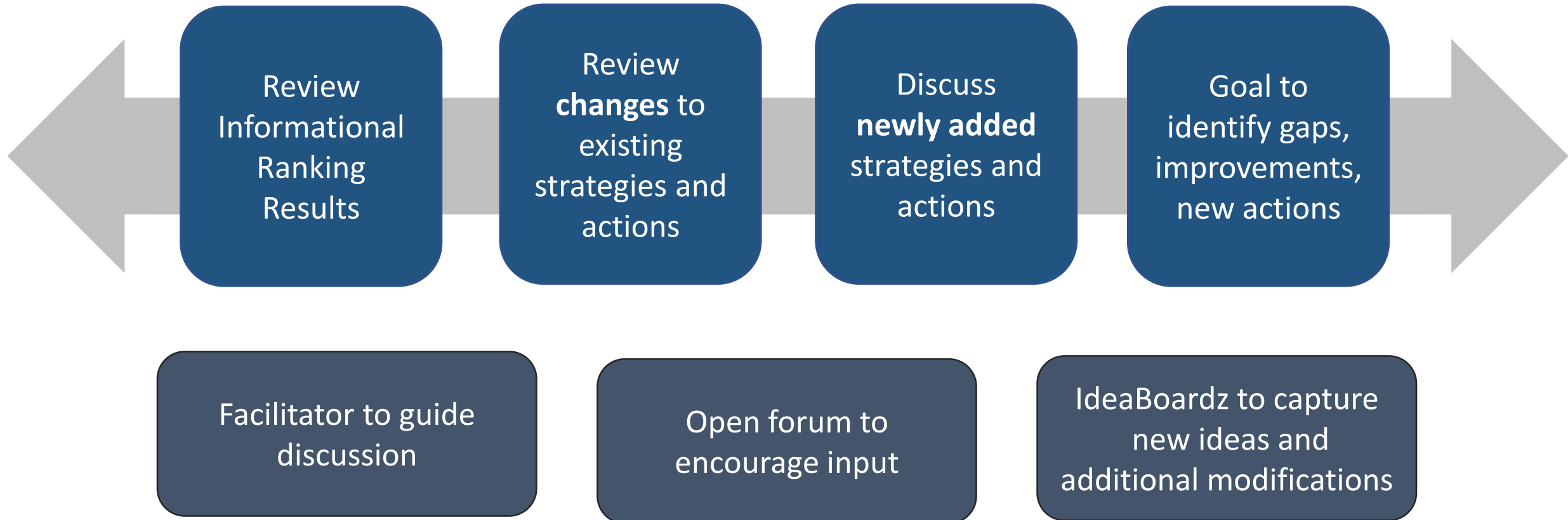

# Goal # 8: Environment

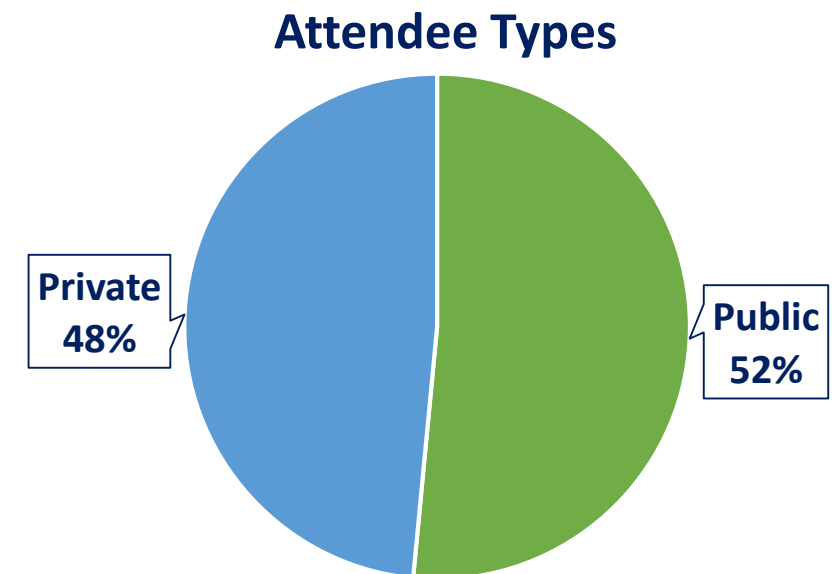
Reduce the local and cumulative environmental impacts of transportation projects, improve air and water quality, energy conservation and mitigate climate change.

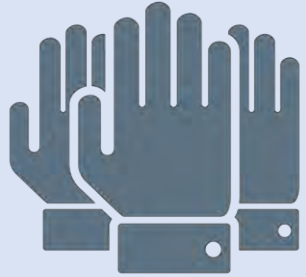

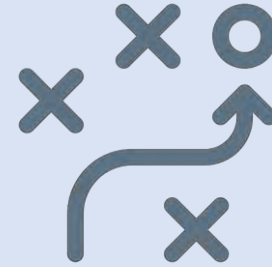

- Workshop input integrated into comprehensive list of revised strategies & actions (~ *May 2020*)
- Activity #1 work group “soundboard/fatal flaw” review of workshop output and input on informational ranking process and tool (~ *June – August 2020*)
- Present final workshop results, introduce informational ranking process and survey tool (~ *June 2020*)
- Informational ranking survey on revised strategies & actions (~ *June – August 2020*)
  - Informs Infrastructure & Systems Subcommittee on potential priorities
  - Provides another data point when agencies are exploring future investments in the near-term
- Present revised strategies & actions, and informational ranking results to Infrastructure & Systems Subcommittee for discussion and final prioritization recommendations (~ *September 2020*)
- Encourage other Subcommittees to develop their goals, strategies & actions (*Ongoing*)
- Recommend revised strategies & actions, and prioritization to AV Executive Committee and Transportation Commission for adoption (~ *September – December 2020*)
