Identify potential challenges, including funding, regulation, legislation, education, etc.	Amend RCW 46.37.480 – Television View, to allow for automated technology such as platooning.
	Current statute prohibits motor vehicles being equipped with any television viewer, screen, or other means of visually receiving a broadcast with moving images while a driver is operating a vehicle. The only current exceptions are for back-up cameras and law enforcement.
	Certain automated technologies, such as platooning, have the second vehicle in a platoon utilize a screen showing real-time roadway information and analysis from the first vehicle. This allows the second vehicle to closely follow the first vehicle while still receiving information about the conditions ahead.
